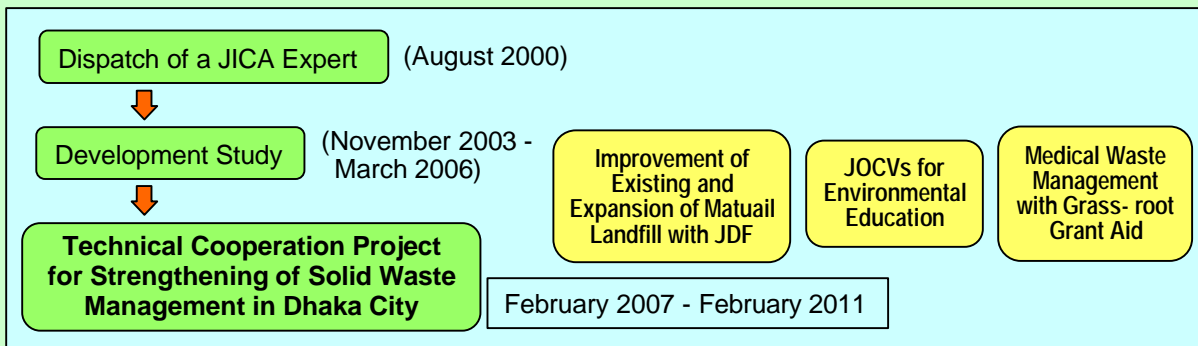
Project for Strengthening of Solid Waste Management in Dhaka City

Background of the Project

The project is a “Technical Cooperation Project” of Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA). Technical cooperation by JICA for solid waste management (SWM) in Dhaka city started with dispatch of a expert, followed by a “Development Study”, in which a master plan on SWM in Dhaka City (**Clean Dhaka Master Plan**) was formulated and

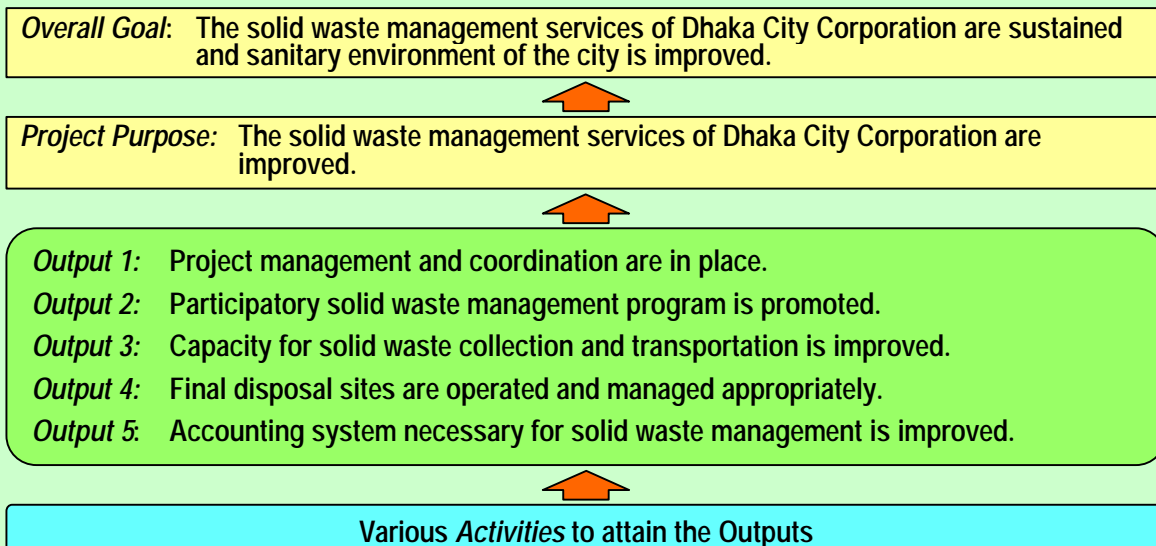
preparatory activities for the master plan implementation were carried out. The Project is to support for the implementation of Clean Dhaka Master Plan. Along with JICA Technical Corporation, Government of Japan has been assisting the SWM sector in Dhaka City by adopting various schemes.



Project Framework

The Project aims at Capacity Development to improve SWM services of Dhaka City Corporation (DCC). Five Outputs are set to achieve the Project Purpose. These outputs correspond to priority programs recommended in the Clean Dhaka Master Plan.

Various Activities are planned to attain the five outputs. Members of Project Team, consisting DCC Counterpart and JICA Expert Team actively participated to the workshop to review the Activities.

< Capacity Development >

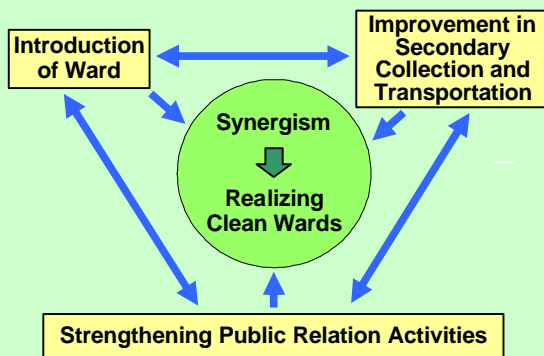
“Capacity Development” is a broader concept of capacity enhancement comprising three levels of the target groups. Since SWM involves various stakeholders, capacity of society to achieve clean city

is important element of the Project. Emphasis of capacity development in the Project will be placed on organisation level, focussing on Waste Management Department to be established.

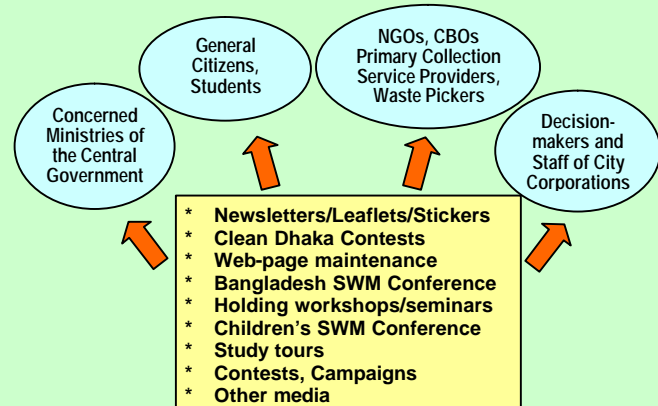
< Intensive Resource Input to Focal Areas >
